Tube Colors:

Alizarin Crimson

Cadmium Red Light

Cadmium Yellow Light

Cobalt Blue

Ultramarine Blue

Phthalocyanine green (Windsor Green – blue shade) or Viridian

Burnt Sienna (or transparent red oxide)

Raw sienna

Permanent Rose

(Artist grade paints are preferred as the student grades are very difficult to work with.)

Palette (I recommend Robert Wood)

2B drawing pencil

White plastic eraser

Box of tissues – white plain

Container for water

Masking, drafting or artist's tape

Board to tape down

Watercolor paper – 300# cold press (140# is OK but I prefer 300#)

Brushes:*

½ inch or 1 inch flat for washes

No. 2 round for detail

No. 8 or 10 round

Any other favorites

*Brushes vary greatly. Every brand and series number varies.
