### Supply List:

Matt board 18" x 24"

Dowel rods- two of each, 3 ft. long X  $\frac{3}{8}$ , &  $\frac{1}{2}$

Regular pottery tools

Pair of scissors

Cheap paring knife

3 – 4 feet of Braded nylon or string line

Three nails- either 6 or 8 penny common nails

Small hammer

Stanley Surform 10" Half Round Rasp replacement blade (blade only)

Stanley Surform 10" Flat Fine Cut Rasp replacement blade (blade only)

Heavy-duty Utility Knife

### TARPAPER WORKSHOP: Materials & supplies: (cont.)





This one is a square



This one is a tapered rectangle



These are some examples of wood frames. Use your imagination.

**½ " Birch plywood :**

\*For a square form the wood needed - 4 pieces ½ inch X 4" X 10"

\*For a rectangular form the wood needed –

2 pieces ½ inch X 4" X 10" & 2 pieces ½ inch X 6" X 10"

I will demonstrate a number of tarpaper shaping techniques. Simple & complex.
