Visual Arts Descriptions

Adventures in 3D Printing Are you excited about 3D printing? We are! In this class students begin by building a 3D printer and then learn to use a 3D design software to manipulate basic shapes, symbols and texts to create 3D designs.

Art Discovery Zone Students explore a variety of materials and mediums while discovering new techniques and styles from around the world. Projects include painting, drawing, clay, print making and more!

Art in Motion Mix movement and art to discover new artistic possibilities! Participate in activities that get you moving, and try your hand at projects like mobile construction, kinetic sculptures and action painting.

Beads, Bracelets and Beyond In this exciting class students will design and create their own jewelry. Students will learn about different techniques including beading, wire work, stringing, crimping and more.

Clay Exploration Explore the wonders of clay. Imagination is your guide to making all kinds of objects from bowls and cups to characters and creatures. Students learn hand building techniques including pinching, slabs and coils.

Colors of the Seasons Enjoy painting, printmaking, clay, and mixed-media projects that center around the seasons, such as winter landscape paintings, autumn leaf collages, spring animal sculptures and summer flower printmaking.

Cookonomics: Tasty Tacos Learn to cook, prepare and assemble the tastiest tacos! Hard shell, soft shell, meat, vegetarian and even dessert tacos...the choices are endless!

Cookonomics: Thanksgiving Treats Get in the holiday spirit by cooking up tasty Thanksgiving treats! Students will make Apple Pie Rollups as well as Turkey Pops made out of candies, cookies and other delicious decorations.

Discover the Potter's Wheel Sitting at the potter's wheel and forming a spectacular bowl or vase is very gratifying. Students learn the basics of wedging, centering, and throwing clay on the wheel. Pieces are finished with colorful glazes for a professional look.

Dreamscapes Bring your dreams to life in this exciting class. Picturing a surreal landscape? Or a mythical creature that never existed? Explore a world of fun and fantasy through art in dreamscapes, where the only limit to what you can create is your own imagination.

Intro to Filmmaking And the Oscar goes to...you! If you've ever wanted to see your face on the big screen, then this is the class for you. In this class students will create, write, act and edit their own short film.

Let's Paint! Students get to try their hand at a new and different painting experience each class such as watercolor, acrylics, collage, oil and pastels.

Spook-tacular Art Prepare for Halloween by creating spook-tacular art! Black cats, haunted houses, spider webs or monsters...the possibilities for a Halloween masterpiece are endless. Come ready for a scary good time!

Stop Motion Animation Dive into the movie making process and learn how to animate an inanimate object using anything from modeling clay and toys to construction blocks and drawings. Students will learn to use the HUE Animation Studio software and camera while creating their own scripts, storyboards, backdrops and characters.

Think 3D: Sculpture Explore sculpture techniques and styles while working with clay, metal, wire, fabric, wood and found objects. Learn about balance, form, stability, weight, gravity and motion while creating abstract and realistic 3D works of art.
