Participation in theatre is proven to enhance professional communication techniques that, with practice, help build confidence, unleash creativity and cultivate teamwork to assist in real-life situations at home and school. There will be a showcase at the end of the session for family and friends.

Acting Intensive Level 3

Have you ever wanted the opportunity to spend a week in the mind of a character? Study acting from the inside out? Get tips and techniques from professional directors? In this camp actors will walk away with all of that and more. The scenes and monologues campers study will be something they can carry with them in auditions for years to come. Experiences in this class will not only enhance students' characters on stage and in front of the camera but also in real life. Communication, teamwork and real listening skills will be heightened every day.

Advanced Improv Skills and Performance

Paint Like Picasso
