Each year the Center for the Arts Bonita Springs welcomes college and adult interns to assist with classes, offices and programming in visual and performing arts. Volunteer interns can make a commitment to work single days, multiple days and even weeks in a particular program. Scheduling is finalized at least one week prior to working.

The Center for the Arts will credit volunteers' work with community service hours and, upon request, write a recommendation letter for the volunteer. This letter is helpful for college and employment. Also, after completing 20 hours of service, interns receive a \$100 Gift Certificate which can be used for programming at the Centers for the Arts.
