

Charcoal Pour Workshop

Join in the fun of an unusual beginning for your painting. You'll use powdered charcoal in a free-spirited pour with water for a base. You will further your painting with realistic or abstract shapes in watercolor, acrylic or pastel.

There will be a 30-minute break for drying papers, eating lunch, and making plans for completion.

Supply list:

2 oz. of powdered charcoal-mars black

1 or 2 pieces of 140 lb or higher watercolor paper-no smooth

surfaces-size 11 x 15 or larger up to 22 x 30"

spray bottle for water-small & big if possible

spray fixative such as Krylon, Spectra, Windsor Newton, etc.

watercolor, acrylic, or pastel paints, brushes, palette, paper towels

Please wear old clothes with an apron and bring gloves
(Instructor will have nitrile gloves if you don't have).

This isn't a "neat" activity but it is fun & sooo creative.
